## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

McGuire FlexBond TPO Primer is an adhesion promoter intended to aid adhesion of 100% silicone and saline-terminated polyurethane coatings and sealants to new and aged TPO roofing membranes.

This product is manufactured from a fast evaporating solvent carrier and adhesive resins. A blue pigment is added to the standard product so that the applicator can better gauge application rates.

## APPLICATION

All surfaces must be clean and completely dry. Apply FlexBond with a short nap roller or brush at the rate of one gallon per 800-1000 sq. ft. Applications should be as thin as possible. Allow one to two hours before applying coatings or sealants.
